**Fisheries Cooperatives and Institutional Support**

2886 Shri Sana Sathish Babu:

Will the Minister of Cooperation be pleased to state:

- (a) the State-wise number of fisheries cooperatives registered across country, especially in Andhra Pradesh with district-wise details thereof;
- (b) the component-wise funds allocated, released and utilised for fishermen cooperatives during last five years, State-wise, especially in Andhra Pradesh;
- (c) the State-wise number of Fishery Producer Organisations (FPOs/FFPOs) registered, especially in Andhra Pradesh with district-wise details thereof;
- (d) the number of fisheries cooperatives selected as Fish Farmer Producer Organisations by NCDC, State-wise, especially in Andhra Pradesh; and
- (e) the loans provided by NCDC during last five years for infrastructure, processing, cold chains, modernisation and deep-sea trawlers, years-wise, State-wise and district-wise for Andhra Pradesh?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF COOPERATION

(a) As per the National Cooperative Database (NCD), there are a total of 27,580 fishery cooperative societies across the country, out of which 2,076 fishery cooperative societies are registered in the State of Andhra Pradesh. The State-wise total number of fishery cooperative societies is enclosed as **Annexure-1**. The district-wise total number of fishery cooperative societies in Andhra Pradesh is enclosed as **Annexure-2**.

(b) National Fisheries Development Board (NFDB), under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) Scheme, is facilitating the formation of 6,000 new Fisheries Cooperative Societies (FCS) during 2024-25 to 2028-29, with financial support of ₹3.00 lakh for each newly formed fisheries cooperative societies towards establishment, maintenance, training of members.

During 2024–25, NFDB sanctioned financial assistance of ₹3,153 lakh for 1,051 newly formed Fisheries Cooperative Societies at the rate of ₹3 lakh per society, out of which ₹2,101 lakh has been released towards the first and second instalments. Further, during 2025–26, financial

assistance of ₹522 lakh has been sanctioned for 174 newly formed fisheries cooperative societies at the same rate of ₹3 lakh per society, out of which ₹348 lakh has been released towards the first and second instalments. The State-wise details of funds allocated and released to new fishery cooperatives by NFDB, is attached as **Annexure-3**.

(c) Under the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY), National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC) registered 70 new Fish Farmer Producer Organisations (FFPOs) in the initial phase. The State-wise number of 70 new FFPOs registered is attached as **Annexure-4**. District-wise details of new FFPOs in Andhra Pradesh are attached as **Annexure-5**.

(d) In addition, the Department of Fisheries, Government of India, allocated the work of converting 1000 existing fisheries cooperative societies into FFPOs to the NCDC. NCDC has identified 1000 Primary Fisheries Cooperatives Societies to strengthen as FFPOs. The State-wise number of fisheries cooperative societies selected as FFPOs is attached as **Annexure-6**.

(e) The State-wise details of the financial assistance provided by NCDC for the procurement of deep-sea trawlers is attached as **Annexure-7**.
