ALLOCATION AND UTILISATION OF SC FUNDS

Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:-

- (a) total budgetary allocation made under the Scheduled Caste Sub Plan (SCSP) and details on both targeted and non-targeted schemes, during each of the last five financial years, scheme-wise, year-wise and State-wise/Union Territory-wise;
- (b) Revised Estimates (RE) for such allocations during the same period, scheme-wise, year-wise and State-wise/Union Territory-wise; and
- (c) actual expenditure incurred under these targeted and non-targeted schemes during the last five years, scheme-wise, year-wise and State-wise/Union Territory-wise?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) The Government of India earmarks funds for the welfare and development of Scheduled Castes under the Development Action Plan for Scheduled Castes (DAPSC), earlier known as the Scheduled Caste Sub Plan (SCSP). Under DAPSC, funds are allocated by 38 Ministries/Departments across 229 schemes for implementation of schemes and programmes benefiting Scheduled Castes. The total budgetary allocation, revised estimates and actual expenditure incurred under DAPSC during the last five financial years is given in below Table:
