CCTV SURVEILLANCE SYSTEMS AT RAILWAY STATIONS IN ODISHA

3322 SHRI NIRANJAN BISHI:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether CCTV surveillance systems have been installed at all major railway stations in Odisha especially in western Odisha; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and remaining stations yet to be covered?

(a) & (b): Installation of CCTV Surveillance Systems is planned at all crossing railway stations in the State of Odisha including in Western Odisha. Further;

- CCTV installation has already been completed at 70 stations in the State of Odisha which includes 15 major stations.
- In Western Odisha, major stations provided with CCTV Surveillance System coverage are Jharsuguda, Rourkela, Sambalpur, Balangir and Titlagarh.

Installation of CCTV system at stations across Indian Railways is a continuous and ongoing process. So far, CCTV cameras have been installed at 1825 stations across Indian Railways.
