Will the Minister of *Coal* be pleased to state:

- (a) the subsidiaries for which the budget is proposed to be spent by Coal India Limited (CIL) under its Community Development/Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) scheme during the current Financial Year along with the amount thereof;
- (b) the areas of subsidiaries where amount is proposed to be spent along with quantum and item-wise details thereof and the project-wise amount spent so far; and
- (c) if so, the amount is not spent so far, the reasons therefor?

(a): In accordance with the provisions of the Companies Act 2013, the statutory amount required to be spent on CSR by Coal India Limited (CIL) and its subsidiaries during FY 2025-26 is as under:

(b): As per the CSR policy of CIL, subsidiaries are required to allocate at least 80% of their annual CSR budget within a 25 kilometre radius of their Project Sites/Mines/Area HQ/Company HQ and rest 20% in the state(s) of operation. Coal India Limited (HQ) is empowered to undertake CSR projects anywhere in the country, but must allocate its resources across multiple states and thematic priorities. Further, the budget is spent on CSR activities under various items of Schedule VII of Companies Act 2013. The key items on which CSR fund is spent are as under:

1. Healthcare, Nutrition and Sanitation
2. Education, Skilling and Livelihood
3. Rural Development
4. Promotion of Sports and
5. Environment Conservation and Sustainability.

Details of subsidiary-wise, project-wise amount spent on major projects during financial year 2025-26 are given under Annexure-I.

The CSR expenditure is accounted for upon receipt of Utilisation Certificates (UCs) against funds disbursed or upon settlement of bills for completed works. Accordingly, the expenditure

figures are based upon UCs/bills received relating to ongoing as well as previously sanctioned works. Considering the ongoing activities sanctioned in the current as well previous financial years, the overall CSR expenditure position of CIL is generally aligned with the prescribed requirements, subject to year-end accounting and receipt of requisite documentation.
