**3625.# SHRI RAJENDRA GEHLOT:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of children and pregnant women registered on the Universal Immunization (U-WIN) portal in the country, particularly in the districts of Rajasthan, as of date;
- (b) whether QR code-based vaccination certificates were issued for each dose of vaccine administered during the year 2025, if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether the U-WIN portal has helped in identifying children who had not received any vaccination earlier, if so, the details thereof along with the number of such unvaccinated children brought under the immunization coverage in the said districts?

**ANSWER**

**THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE  
(SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)**

- (a) As on 18<sup>th</sup> March 2026, 11.87 cr. children and 3.96 cr. pregnant women are registered Nationally on U-WIN portal. The District-wise detail of Rajasthan is at Annexure.
- (b) After every vaccination event, beneficiaries can download the QR code-based vaccination certificate from U-WIN portal. In the year 2025, 8.01 crore beneficiaries were registered in U-WIN and the digital QR code-based certificates are digitally available.
- (c) U-WIN has helped in line-listing of children due for vaccination. These children are digitally mapped on the portal for regular follow-ups with SMS alerts for ensuring their due doses. List of beneficiaries who do not turn up is automatically generated for follow-up to ensure necessary vaccination in another session. This is an ongoing and continuous process of mapping and identification under immunization
