CAPACITY AND SERVICES AT AIIMS BHUBANESWAR

3647. SHRI SUBHASISH KHUNTIA

Will the **Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the sanctioned and functional bed strength at AIIMS Bhubaneswar has been assessed vis-a-vis the average daily OPD and IPD patient load, and, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the existing capacity is considered adequate to meet current patient inflow;
- (c) whether the number of sanctioned and vacant faculty and specialist posts has been reviewed and, if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether super-speciality departments are fully operational and the average waiting period for major surgeries; and
- (e) whether any expansion plan is under consideration and, if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): Established under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY), All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Bhubaneswar has 1028 functional beds. The number of OPD and IPD patients who have availed treatment in AIIMS Bhubaneswar in the year 2024-25 is as under:

(c): The details of sanctioned posts and filled posts at AIIMS Bhubaneswar is as under:

The creation and filling of posts at AIIMS is a continuous process. In 2025, 81 additional posts (Faculty/Non-faculty) have been created for AIIMS Bhubaneswar.

(d) & (e): At AIIMS Bhubaneswar, 35 Departments (including Specialty and Super-Specialty) are functional. Waiting period for surgeries for patients in the Institute is contingent upon the patient's medical condition, urgency of treatment required and availability of bed. The expansion of various facilities in the Institute is taken up in a phased manner.
