GPDPs ON EGRAMSWARAJ PORTAL

Will the Minister of PANCHAYATI RAJ be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Gram Panchayats that have prepared and uploaded Gram Panchayat Development Plans (GPDPs) on eGramSwaraj portal during the last three years; and
- (b) the percentage of approved works actually completed within the financial year?

ANSWER

(a) Panchayat, being “Local Self Government”, is a State subject. However, the Ministry of Panchayati Raj promotes decentralized planning and effective implementation of development works through the Gram Panchayat Development Plan (GPDP) framework. Gram Panchayats prepare and upload their GPDPs on the eGramSwaraj portal, which serves as a comprehensive digital platform for planning, budgeting, accounting, and monitoring of Panchayat activities.

The preparation of GPDPs is undertaken annually through a participatory process involving Gram Sabhas, and the plans include works and activities to be implemented through the convergence of various Central and State schemes.

The details of the number of Gram Panchayats that have prepared and uploaded GPDPs on eGramSwaraj:

(b) As stated above, Panchayat, being “Local Self Government”, is a State subject. Therefore, the respective State Governments monitor the status of implementation of approved works.

However, the Gram Panchayats prepare and upload their GPDPs on the e-GramSwaraj portal, which serves as a comprehensive digital platform for planning, budgeting, accounting, and monitoring of Panchayat activities. As per the information available on the e-GramSwaraj portal, the execution of approved works carried out by the respective Gram Panchayats is at different stages of implementation. However, the project completion status available on the e-GramSwaraj portal may not accurately reflect the actual status of completion, as same is not updated regularly at the Gram Panchayat level. Also, execution of projects taken up during the year often spills over into the subsequent year.
