**EMERGING SKILLS INTEGRATION UNDER PMKVY 4.0 IN BIHAR**

3785. SHRI SHAMBHU SHARAN PATEL:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state: -

- (a) the current status of implementation of Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) 4.0, including details of sectoral coverage and geographical expansion;
- (b) the provisions made under the scheme to include customised and future skill-based job roles in emerging sectors;
- (c) the details of the institutional mechanism supporting PMKVY 4.0, including the details of participation and utilisation of funds;
- (d) whether convergence with other national flagship schemes has been implemented to align skill development with regional priorities; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(SHRI JAYANT CHAUDHARY)

(a) Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) is implementing Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana 4.0 (PMKVY 4.0) since 2022, for imparting skill development training through Short-Term Training (STT) and up-skilling and re-skilling through Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) to the youth across the country. The PMKVY 4.0 has been implemented across the country covering 36 sectors such as Agriculture, Apparel, Automotive, Beauty and Wellness, BFSI, Capital Goods, Construction, Electronics and Hardware, Food Processing, Furniture and Fittings, Gems and Jewellery, Green Jobs, Healthcare, Hydrocarbon, Iron and Steel, IT-ITeS, Leather, Life Sciences, Power, Rubber, Sports, Telecom, Textiles and Handlooms, Tourism & Hospitality, etc.

State/UT-wise candidates trained/ oriented and certified under PMKVY 4.0, till 31.12.2025, is at *Annexure-I*.

(b) Under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) 4.0, provisions have been made to include future skill-based job roles in emerging sectors by offering training in National Council for Vocational Education and Training (NCVET)-approved courses, which are suitably customised to industry requirements and evolving market demand. NCVET has approved more than 600 job roles across emerging sectors such as Drone Technology, Artificial Intelligence (AI), Robotics, Mechatronics, etc., thereby ensuring availability of industry-relevant and future-ready skilling opportunities.

(c) The details of institutional ecosystem supporting PMKVY 4.0 is as under:

- **Policy & Governance:** Led by the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE), which provides overall direction and funding.
- **Implementation:** Managed by the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC)
- **Industry Interface:** Sector Skill Councils (SSCs) and other Awarding Bodies design standards, develop curriculum, and facilitate certification aligned with industry needs.

- **Training Network:** Delivered through Institutes of Central Ministries/Departments, PSUs, State Skill Development Missions, Industries, Industry Associations, ITIs, Polytechnics, Higher Education Institutions, Training Providers, Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendras (PMKKs), etc.
- **Digital & Quality Systems:** Skill India Digital Hub, stringent monitoring mechanism and NSQF-based certification ensure transparency and quality.

PMKVY 4.0 is a demand driven scheme, wherein training centres are accredited/ affiliated based on the proposals submitted by the Project Implement Agencies, after taking the skill gap into account. Under the Scheme, more than 15,000 training centres were accredited/ affiliated for imparting project based skilling. As on 31.12.2025, ₹2549.90Cr. has been utilized for imparting skilling under PMKVY 4.0.

(d) & (e) The Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) ensures convergence of skilling efforts across multiple Ministries/Departments through a Whole-of-Government approach, ensuring better and more effective implementation of skill development programs. By providing skill training to adolescent girls and sanitation workers, MSDE focuses on empowering the country's vulnerable groups. For providing skilling in the border villages of the country, the Ministry is working closely with Ministry of Home Affairs for the development of these geographically challenging areas. MSDE is actively collaborating with various Ministries and Departments to align skilling initiatives with national priorities and the specific skill requirements of different government schemes.
