SKILL TRAINING IN THE STATE OF RAJASTHAN

3790. SHRI RAJENDRA GEHLOT:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government possesses any data regarding the total number of individuals who received skill training under various Central and Centrally Sponsored Schemes in the State of Rajasthan during the last three years and the current financial year, if so, the district-wise details thereof;
- (b) the district-wise details of the number of individuals securing employment out of those trained under the said schemes; and
- (c) the district-wise details regarding the amount of financial assistance provided under the said schemes in the State of Rajasthan during the said period?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(a) to (c): Under the Government of India's Skill India Mission (SIM), the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) delivers skill, re-skill and up-skill training through an extensive network of skill development centres / institutes etc. under various schemes, viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) and Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs), to all the sections of the society across the country including the state of Rajasthan. The SIM aims at enabling youth of India to get future ready and equipped with industry relevant skills. Skilling is done through various the Central Sector Schemes under the Skill India Programme, as also the Centrally Sponsored Schemes like Strengthening of Infrastructure for Institutional Training and Pradhan Mantri Skilling and Employability Transformation through Upgraded ITIs (PM SETU) scheme.

The number of individuals who have received skill training under various schemes of MSDE in the state of Rajasthan (District-wise) during the last three years and the current financial year, upto December, 2025, is at Annexure.

Amongst the schemes of MSDE, placements were tracked under the Short-Term Training component of PMKVY in the first three versions (PMKVY 1.0, PMKVY 2.0 and PMKVY 3.0) implemented from 2015-16 to 2021-22. Under PMKVY 4.0, the focus is on empowering our trained candidates to choose their varied career path and they are suitably oriented for the same. Skill India Digital Hub (SIDH) provides a wide range of courses for skill training and facilitates access to jobs and apprenticeship opportunities for the trained candidates available on SIDH portal. Further, Kaushal Melas and PM National Apprenticeship Melas (PMNAMs) have been organized to facilitate the placements opportunities to the certified candidates.

Funds are not released directly to the districts under any schemes of MSDE. Funds under PMKVY are released to implementing agencies for meeting the training cost as per prescribed norms. Under JSS scheme, funds are released to Non- Governmental Organizations (NGOs) directly. Under NAPS, stipend support up to Rs 1500/- per month is released to apprentices through DBT and not to establishments covered. Day to day administration as well as financial control in respect of ITIs lies with the respective State Government/ UT Administration. The details of funds released under various schemes of MSDE to the state of Rajasthan during the last three years and the current financial year, upto December 2025, is

given as under:

Apart from MSDE, more than 20 Central Ministries are implementing Skilling/ Upskilling training programmes through various Central sector/Centrally sponsored schemes, such as Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU- GKY), the Rural Self Employment Training Institutes (RSETIs) under Ministry of Rural Development, Deen Dayal Antyodaya Yojana – National Urban Livelihood Mission (NULM) under Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs etc.
