IMPLEMENTATION STATUS UNDER AMRUT IN TAMIL NADU

4057. SHRI R. DHARMAR:

Will the Minister of *Housing and Urban Affairs* be pleased to state:

- (a) the current implementation status of projects taken up under the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) in the country during the last five years, State-wise including the State of Tamil Nadu;
- (b) the funds allocated for the projects under AMRUT during the last five years within the State;
- (c) whether Government proposes to extend the AMRUT to new cities and towns;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the number of cities rejuvenated since the launch of the said scheme in the country including the State of Tamil Nadu?

ANSWER

**THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS
(SHRI TOKHAN SAHU)**

(a) & (b): Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) was launched on 25 June 2015 in selected 500 cities (485 cities including 15 merged cities) and towns across the country focussing on development of basic infrastructure in the sectors of water supply; sewerage and septage management; storm water drainage; green spaces and parks; and non-motorized urban transport. Under AMRUT, 6000 projects worth ₹83,493.22 crore have been taken up of which works worth ₹81,177.67 crore have been physically completed. State/ Union Territory (UT) wise details including Tamil Nadu is given in Annexure.

In Tamil Nadu, 28 cities (including 5 merged cities) have been taken up under AMRUT. Under AMRUT, Central funds are allocated at the start of the Mission and not year-wise. As reported by the State on AMRUT portal, 445 projects worth ₹13,339.43 crore have been grounded in Tamil Nadu of which works worth ₹13,081.33 crore have been physically completed. Under AMRUT, total central assistance of ₹4626.24 crore has been released to the State of which ₹2562.34 crore has been released during last five years (from 2020-21 to 2024-25).

(c) to (e): To carry forward the objective of universal coverage of water supply from 500 cities to all Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) in the country, AMRUT 2.0 has been launched on 1st Oct 2021 in all Urban Local Bodies (ULBs)/ cities, enabling the cities to become 'self-reliant' and 'water secure'. Providing universal coverage of sewerage & septage management in 500 AMRUT cities is other major focus of AMRUT 2.0. Rejuvenation of water bodies and development of green spaces and parks are other components of the Mission. Under AMRUT 2.0, States/ Union Territories (UTs) are empowered to select, appraise, prioritize and implement the projects within the broad framework of AMRUT 2.0 guidelines. As updated by the States/ UTs on AMRUT 2.0 portal, State Water Action Plans (SWAPs) comprising of 8,771 projects worth ₹1,92,482.52 crore in 3351 ULBs have been approved.

Under AMRUT 2.0, the State of Tamil Nadu has taken up 1263 projects worth ₹14,637.74 crore including Central Assistance of ₹4,942 crore in 604 ULBs/ cities.
