(a) to (d): The "Hamari Dharohar" scheme has been implemented from FY 2014-15 to FY 2021-22 and has now been converged into the Pradhan Mantri Virasat ka Samvardhan (PM VIKAS) Scheme which was rolled out in January, 2025.

During the last two years, under the Traditional Training Sub- component of PM VIKAS Scheme in which "Hamari Dharohar" has been converged, a conclave titled "Buddha's Madhyama Marg to guide future Global Leadership" was organised by the Ministry in collaboration with International Buddhist Confederation in Mumbai on 14th September, 2024.
