LPG CONNECTIONS UNDER PMUY

4116 DR. JOHN BRITTAS:

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) total number of LPG connections that have been provided under the Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) since its inception;
- (b) the details thereof, year-wise and State-wise;
- (c) State-wise average annual consumption of LPG cylinders by PMUY beneficiaries and the corresponding average annual consumption by non-PMUY domestic consumers;
- (d) the details and quantum of Direct benefit Transfer (DBT) subsidy disbursed to domestic LPG consumers during the last five years; and
- (e) the details thereof, State-wise and year-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS

(SHRI SURESH GOPI)

(a) & (b): Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) was launched in May, 2016 with an objective to provide deposit free LPG connection to adult women from poor households. As on 01.03.2026, there were about 10.56 crore PMUY connections across the country. Year-wise and State/UT-wise, details of PMUY connections released since inception are at **Annexure-A**.

(c): Details of State-wise, Per Connection Consumption of PMUY and Non-PMUY beneficiaries are at **Annexure-B**.

(d) & (e): Funds under DBTL and PMUY are not allocated/utilized state-wise. The scheme-wise details of subsidy on domestic LPG during last five years are given below:

In addition to above subsidy, Government has also released a compensation of Rs. 22,000 crore to OMCs in FY 2022-23 for under recoveries incurred by OMCs on sale of Domestic LPG. During FY 2025-26, Government has approved another compensation of Rs. 30,000 crore.
