ESTABLISHMENT OF CANCER DAY CARE CENTERS

453. SHRI K.R. SURESH REDDY:

Will the Minister **OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has announced the setting up of 200 cancer day care centres in district hospitals during the financial year 2025–26 under the Union Budget 2025–26;
- (b) the details of funds allocated for the establishment of these new cancer day care centres since February, 2025;
- (c) the details of funds disbursed for the said purpose since February, 2025, State-wise;
- (d) the number of new cancer day care centres that have been established since February, 2025 and the number of such centres that are fully functional at present, State/UT-wise;
- (e) the sanctioned patient intake capacity of these centres; and
- (f) the actual number of patients treated at these centres since February, 2025, State/UTwise?

**ANSWER

- (a) As per the announcement of Union Budget 2025-26, the government plans to set up Day Care Cancer Centres (DCCCs) in all district hospitals in the next 3 years, out of which 200 centres are to be set up in Financial Year 2025-26. For FY 2025-26, Department of Health and Family Welfare has approved 297 DCCCs for establishment across the country.
- (b) The Budget norms for new Day Care Cancer Centre is Rs. 241.1 Lakhs (non-recurring cost of Rs 91.3 Lakhs and recurring cost of Rs 149.8 Lakhs) per Unit.
- (c) State/UT-wise fund released under National Programme for Non-Communicable Diseases (NP-NCD) (excluding Planning & M&E) from FY 2025-26(till 23.01.2026) is attached at Annexure-I. This includes fund released towards establishment of DCCCs in State/UTs.
- (d) 297 DCCCs have been approved by The Department of Health & Family Welfare, out of which 102 DCCCs are functional as per details provided by States/UTs. The State/UT-wise List of Approved and Functional DCCCs is at Annexure –II.
- (e) and (f) District Day Care Cancer Centre is designed to operate as 4-6 beds, within existing district hospital premises. Respective State Governments may increase number of beds as per their requirement.
