AMMONIA-UREA PLANT AT NAMRUP

103: SHRI JOGEN MOHAN:

Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has reviewed the progress of the proposed 4th Ammonia-Urea Plant at Brahmaputra Valley Fertilizer Corporation Limited (BVFCL), Namrup;
- (b) if so, the details of the action taken so far,
- (c) whether the project is expected to enhance domestic Urea production and reduce dependence on imports; and
- (d) if so, the estimated production capacity thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

Statement referred to in reply to parts (a) to (d) in respect of Rajya Sabha Starred Question No. 103 for reply on 28.07.2026 regarding Ammonia-Urea plant at Namrup asked by Shri Jogen Mohan.

(a) & (b): The Cabinet in its meeting held on 19.03.2025 approved the proposal for setting up of a new Brownfield Ammonia-Urea Complex of 12.7 Lakh Metric Tonnes (LMT) annual capacity of Urea production within the existing premises of Brahmaputra Valley Fertilizer Corporation Limited (BVFCL), Namrup, Assam, at an estimated total project cost of Rs.10601.40 crore through a Joint Venture company. The foundation stone of the project was laid by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 21.12.2025. The tentative overall time schedule for commissioning of the project is 48 months.

The Cabinet-approved equity pattern of the Joint Venture Company, incorporated on 25.07.2025, namely, Assam Valley Fertilizer and Chemical Company Limited (AVFCCL) is:

AVFCCL has appointed Projects & Development India Limited (PDIL) as the Project Management Consultant (PMC) for providing Pre-Lump Sum Turnkey (LSTK) services for the proposed Ammonia-Urea Project at Namrup (Assam). Notice Invite Tender (NIT) has been issued. Currently, the pre -project activities are going on.

The Government is regularly reviewing the progress of Namrup-IV Ammonia-Urea Fertilizer plant in consultation with the Government of Assam to ensure adherence to the timely implementation of the project.

(c) & (d): The project is expected to substantially augment indigenous urea production capacity, particularly catering to the fertilizer requirements of the North-Eastern and Eastern regions of the country. Thus, the Namrup-IV project is expected to play a significant role in strengthening domestic fertilizer production capacity and improving long-term fertilizer security in the country.

The project will have an annual installed capacity of 12.70 Lakh Metric Tonnes (LMT) of Neem Coated Urea and comprising of a 2,200 Metric Tonnes Per Day (MTPD) Ammonia Plant and 3,850 MTPD Urea Plant.
