(a) to (c) The Detailed Project Report (DPR) for the Northern part of Regional Ring Road has been prepared.

The proposal for the development of 6-lane Northern Regional Ring Road of Hyderabad city with length of 161.518 km in the State of Telangana under NH(O) on Hybrid Annuity Mode with total capital cost of ₹ 23,935.6 crore has been appraised by the Public Private Partnership Appraisal Committee (PPPAC) in the meeting held on 10.04.2026.

The State Government has conveyed its consent for sharing 50% of the land acquisition cost for the project. The State Government has also agreed to grant exemption from royalty on extraction of minor minerals and reimbursement of the State's portion of Goods and Services Tax (GST) for the project.

Decision for project investment and implementation is taken up based on the outcome of the DPR, requirement of connectivity, traffic density and synergy with the PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan.
