STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY OF PARTS (a) to (e) OF THE RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 14 FOR ANSWER ON 20.07.2026 REGARDING “OBJECTIVES AND KEY COMPONENTS OF NATIONAL URBAN DIGITAL MISSION”

(a) to (e): At present, the National Urban Digital Mission (NUDM) is in the pilot phase only. The pilot implementation of the mission was launched in February, 2021 under which citizen centric urban digital infrastructure named as the Urban Platform for deliverY of Online Governance (UPYOG) is being developed. It comprises a set of e-governance solutions usable by all ULBs for delivery of digital municipal services. It promotes the use of modern technologies in urban governance through the development of the UPYOG platform, which is an open-source, micro services-based and modular digital platform. This architecture enables interoperability, easy customization, and seamless integration with existing State and municipal systems. The year-wise details of the financial allocation made for the implementation of the NUDM mission over the past three years are below, however, the funds remain unutilised due to non-launch of the Mission:
