(a) to (e): The Government of India periodically establishes Institutions of National importance, including Indian Institutes of Management (IIM), across India, after taking into account regional balance and resource availability. Telangana is a major educational hub that hosts several premier central government higher educational institutions, including the University of Hyderabad, Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Hyderabad, National Institute of Technology (NIT) Warangal, English and Foreign Languages University (EFLU), Hyderabad, and Maulana Azad National Urdu University (MANUU), Hyderabad. Further, the Sammakka Sarakka Central Tribal University at Mulugu was established in 2023. As per the All-India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) 2023-24, Telangana hosts 2,070 higher education institutions (HEIs), of these, 604 institutions offer management courses, including 20 universities, 570 colleges, and 14 standalone institutes. At present, 22 IIMs are functioning across the country, and currently there is no proposal under consideration for setting up new IIMs.
