CANCER CARE INFRASTRUCTURE IN THE COUNTRY

1054. SHRI B. PARTHASARADHI REDDY:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has assessed the increasing burden of cancer cases in the country during the last five years;
- (b) the number of Regional Cancer Centres and Government cancer treatment facilities, State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether Government proposes to establish additional cancer treatment centres in underserved districts of the country with special reference to the State of Telangana; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER

(a) Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) – National Cancer Registry Programme (NCRP) has provided the State/UT-wise details of estimated cancer incidence for the last five years (2021–2025), which are annexed at Annexure–I.

(b) to (d) Regional Cancer Centres (RCCs) were earlier supported under the erstwhile National Cancer Control Programme (NCCP). However, the scheme is no longer operational. At present, The Department of Health and Family Welfare is implementing ‘Strengthening of Tertiary Care Cancer Facilities’ Scheme under the National Programme for Prevention and Control of Non-Communicable Diseases. Under the Scheme, support is provided to States and Union Territories for setting up of State Cancer Institutes (SCIs) and Tertiary Care Cancer Centres (TCCCs) in Government Medical College/Hospital or erstwhile Regional Cancer Centre. Till date 39 institutions (19 SCI and 20 TCCC), including MNJ Institute of Oncology & RCC, Hyderabad as a State Cancer Institute in Telangana have been approved across the country. The details of these institutes are given at Annexure–II.

In addition, 524 Day Care Cancer Centres (DCCCs) are functional across the country to ensure cancer care accessibility at district hospital level, out of which 34 DCCCs are functional including underserved districts of Telangana.
