Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the cumulative progress recorded in issuing digital Ayushman Cards to citizens across rural and urban pockets under Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) including the States of Tripura and Bihar;
- (b) the total number of Ayushman Bharat Health Accounts (ABHA) successfully generated and linked to secure medical histories via the digital health ecosystem;
- (c) whether enrolment of senior citizens under the Ayushman Vay Vandana Card is being tracked on the national digital health ecosystem; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a): As on 22.07.2026, a total of 44.73 crore Ayushman cards have been created under Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojna (AB-PMJAY). The State/UT-wise details of Ayushman cards created under the scheme including Tripura and Bihar can be accessed at: <https://dashboard.nha.gov.in/public/card>

(b): Ayushman Bharat Health Account (ABHA) is a key building block of Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission. It is a unique 14-digit health identifier which allows citizens to securely access

and manage their digital health records across the healthcare ecosystem. As on 22.07.2026, a total of 95.05 crore ABHA have been created and 106.48 crore health records have been linked with ABHA across the country. These records form patients' medical histories and can be accessed & shared securely by citizens with their healthcare providers.

(c) and (d): The enrolment and progress of Ayushman Vay Vandana cards is regularly monitored through a real- time dashboard of National Health Authority. As on 22.07.2026, a total of 1.28 crore Ayushman Vay Vandana cards have been created for senior citizens aged 70 years and above.
