(a): Health Dynamics of India (HDI) is an annual publication, based on healthcare administrative data reported by States/UTs. Details of availability of health infrastructure including Primary Health Centres (PHCs), Community Health Centres (CHCs), Sub-Health Centres (SHCs) and other health units established or upgraded across the country including Bihar, district-wise, may be accessed through the HMIS portal under Publications at the following link of HDI 2023-24:

A total of 1.86 lakh Ayushman Arogya Mandirs (AAMs) including 12,444 AAMs in Bihar have been operationalized by strengthening SHCs and PHCs. These AAMs provide preventive, promotive, rehabilitative and curative care for an expanded range of services. The AAMs incrementally provide 12 package of primary health care services across the country, including Bihar, encompassing Reproductive and child care services, Communicable diseases, Non Communicable diseases (NCD), Palliative Care and elderly Care, Care for common mental disorders, neurological conditions (epilepsy, dementia) and substance use disorders management (tobacco, alcohol, drugs), Oral health, ENT care, and Basic emergency care.
