ESTABLISHMENT OF AIIMS IN KERALA

1085. SHRI A. A. RAHIM.

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- a) whether the Union Government has taken follow-up action for the establishment of an All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) in Kerala after the State Government identified and allotted land for the project in Kozhikode district, and if so, the details thereof;
- b) the present status of the proposal, including the preliminary works completed by the Union Government;
- c) the reasons for the delay in obtaining the necessary approvals and commencing construction of AIIMS in Kerala; and
- d) the timeline fixed by Government for completion of the preliminary formalities and commencement of construction of AIIMS in Kerala?

(a) In 2014 and 2016, the State Government of Kerala identified and proposed four sites at following locations for establishment of AIIMS in the State: (i) Kinaloor in Kozhikode district, (ii) Kattakada Taluk in Thiruvananthapuram district, (iii) Kottayam district and (iv) Ernakulam district. In 2025, the State Government of Kerala has informed about identification of land in Kinaloor, Kozhikode district for establishment of AIIMS.

(b) The proposal for establishment of AIIMS in Kerala has not been approved.
