ISSUANCE OF CARDS UNDER AB-PMJAY

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) the details of the record number of more than 43 crore Ayushman cards issued in the country so far under Government's ambitious 'Ayushman Bharat-Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana' (AB-PMJAY) and the free and life-saving treatment provided to the poor and deprived sections through it, State-wise; and

(b) the future roadmap of Government to expand the network of state-of-the-art medical institutions like AIIMS in metros as well as Tier-2, Tier-3 cities and rural areas and to provide world-class healthcare infrastructure to the last mile of the country under the vision of 'Healing in India' and 'Viksit Bharat'?

(a) and (b): As on 22.07.2026, a total of 44.73 crore Ayushman cards have been created under Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojna (AB-PMJAY). The State/UT-wise details of Ayushman cards created can be accessed at <https://dashboard.nha.gov.in/public/card>

The current National Master of Health Benefit Package (HBP-2022) provides cashless healthcare services through 1,961 treatment packages across 27 medical specialties. The packages cover a wide range of secondary and tertiary care services, including non-communicable diseases such as cancer, cardiovascular diseases, chronic kidney disease, diabetes-related complications, stroke, chronic respiratory diseases, neurological disorders, liver diseases etc.

As on 30.06.2026, a total of 12.69 crore hospital admissions amounting to Rs.1.92 lakh crore have been authorized under the scheme thereby providing cashless treatment to eligible beneficiaries. The State/UT-wise details of hospital admissions authorized under AB-PMJAY are at **Annexure**.

The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare is focused on strengthening the foundation of the healthcare system and nearly 1.86 lakh Ayushman Arogya Mandirs have been established across the country, serving as the first point of contact for citizens while creating a robust linkage between primary, secondary and tertiary healthcare. Further the tertiary healthcare infrastructure has been significantly strengthened through the establishment of AIIMS, medical colleges etc. considering the health care needs of the country.
