ESTABLISHMENT OF RASHTRIYA RAKSHA UNIVERSITY CAMPUS IN WEST BENGAL

1184 SHRI SAMIK BHATTACHARYA:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government is aware of absence of any Rashtriya Raksha University (RRU) campus in the state of West Bengal, despite RRU having operational campuses in seven States/UTs including Arunachal Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Puducherry and Jammu & Kashmir;

(b) whether Government has received any demand or proposal for establishing an RRU campus in West Bengal, given its strategic importance as a border State sharing international boundaries with Bangladesh, Nepal and Bhutan;

(c) whether Government proposes to establish an RRU campus in West Bengal in view of its critical security requirements and if so, timeline therefor; and

(d) if not, reasons therefor?

(a) to (d): No proposal has been received from the state government regarding the establishment of a Rashtriya Raksha University (RRU) campus in West Bengal.

The decision to establish new campuses for the Rashtriya Raksha University in the country is based on the institutional requirements for various campuses and availability of infrastructure for the university.

However, the RRU is undertaking training programs on cybercrime investigation for West Bengal Police officers at the Kolkata Police Academy.
