IMPLEMENTATION OF PMFBY IN HARYANA

1449. SMT. REKHA SHARMA:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of farmers enrolled under the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) in Haryana during 2025-26, district-wise;
- (b) the total number and value of crop insurance claims settled in Haryana during the said period;
- (c) whether technology-based crop loss assessment through satellite imagery, drones and remote sensing has been adopted in Haryana for faster claim settlement and, if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the amount of premium subsidy released by the Central Government for Haryana under PMFBY during the last three years, year-wise?

- (a): District-wise details of number of farmer applications enrolled under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) in Haryana during 2025-26 are at **Annexure**.
- (b): As on 24.07.2026, a total of Rs. 918.21 crore, pertaining to 44.69 lakh farmer applications have been settled in Haryana during 2025-26.
- (c): The PMFBY envisages adoption of improved technology in implementation of the scheme. Accordingly, Yield Estimation System Based on Technology (YES-TECH) using remote sensing data is being implemented with effect from Kharif 2023 for objective crop damage, loss assessment. YES-TECH envisages gradual migration to remote sensing based

yield estimation to help in fair and accurate crop yield estimation. The initiative has been launched for paddy and wheat crops w.e.f Kharif 2023 and for soybean crop w.e.f Kharif 2024 season wherein mandatory 30% weightage to yield estimation has been assigned to YES-TECH derived yield. YES-TECH was implemented in 12 States during 2025-26. Government of Haryana started implementing the YESTECH w.e.f. 2023-24 with a weightage of 30% and increased it to 40% in 2025-26.

(d): PMFBY, being a Central Sector Scheme, no funds are released to the States. Central Government share of premium subsidy is provided to the insurance companies through Central Nodal Agency under Treasury Single Account (TSA). However, details of Central Government share of premium subsidy during last three years for Haryana are given below:
