**TRADE INFRASTRUCTURE FOR EXPORT SCHEME PROJECTS IN HIMACHAL
PRADESH**

Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of export infrastructure projects, including cold-chain and logistics facilities, sanctioned for Himachal Pradesh under the Trade Infrastructure for Export Scheme (TIES) during the last five years;
- (b) the funds allocated and released for such projects in Himachal Pradesh, year-wise;
- (c) whether any proposal(s) from Himachal Pradesh under TIES is/are pending, if so, the details and current status thereof; and
- (d) the reasons for delay, if any and corrective measures being taken?

(a) to (b) The Trade Infrastructure for Export Scheme (TIES) provides assistance to eligible Central/State Government agencies and joint ventures for setting up and up-gradation of infrastructure projects with overwhelming export linkages.

The scheme provides assistance on the demand driven basis and proposals received from eligible implementing agencies are placed before the Empowered Committee (EC) on TIES for consideration. In last five years, two project proposals have been sanctioned for Himachal Pradesh. Details of these projects including the allocated funds and released funds (year-wise) are as below:
