Implementation of NAM in Odisha

- (a) the funds sanctioned and released to Odisha under the National AYUSH Mission (NAM) till date;
- (b) the projects approved there under;
- (c) the present status of implementation; and
- (d) the achievements made under the Mission in the State?

(a) to (d) Under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National Ayush Mission (NAM) till date, an amount of Rs. 19461.953 Lakhs has been sanctioned and released to State Government of Odisha for implementation of different activities / projects as approved in the received State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs). As reported by the State Government, they have made expenditure for an amount of Rs 19422.30 Lakhs. The major achievements made under NAM is furnished at **Annexure**.

The major achievements made under NAM in the State of Odisha:

- Operationalization of 422 Ayushman Arogya Mandirs (Ayush) by upgrading the existing Govt. Ayush Dispensaries.
- Establishment of Three 50 bedded Integrated Ayush Hospitals at Dhenkanal, Bhubaneswar and Balasore
- 55 new Government Ayush dispensary buildings have been constructed.
- 18 projects at Govt. Ayush Medical Colleges have been completed for strengthening of Govt. Ayush Educational Institutions.
- Establishment of New Govt. Ayurvedic Medical College at Rairangpur.
- Deployment of Yoga Instructors for promotion of preventive healthcare and healthy lifestyle.
- Expansion of Panchakarma services and specialized Ayush healthcare.
- Improved availability of quality Ayush medicines in all Government Ayush health facilities including all 1,485 Ayush Clinics co-located at PHCs/CHCs/DHs of the State.
- Strengthening of Ayush institutions through infrastructure development, equipment procurement, human resource support and training.
- Implementation of public health initiatives and IEC activities like preparation of Audio-Visual Clips on Strength of Ayush for preventive, promotive and holistic healthcare.
- Promotion of Yoga through Yoga Wellness Centres and community-based programmes.
