**PROGRESS OF SCHEMES FOR
THE DEVELOPMENT OF MSMEs IN BIHAR**

1684. DR. DHARMSHILA GUPTA:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the amount of funds approved and utilised, and the number of new Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise (MSME) units established in the State of Bihar during the last three years under the Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), RAMP, CGTMSE, the Micro and Small Enterprises-Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP), SFURTI, and other major schemes;
- (b) the number of youths, women, and entrepreneurs belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes who have benefited through these schemes; and
- (c) the extent of direct and indirect employment generated in the State through these schemes?

(a) to (c): The Government implements the Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Raising and Accelerating MSME Performance (RAMP), Credit Guarantee Fund Trust for Micro and Small Enterprises (CGTMSE), the Micro and Small Enterprises Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP) and other major schemes such as PM Vishwakarma Scheme (PMV), and National Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Hub (NSSH), across the country, including Bihar. The Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI) was in continuation till 30-09-2022. However, being Central Sector Schemes, the funds are not allocated State/UT-wise. The details related to progress, beneficiaries (including Women, Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes) and employment generated in the state of Bihar, under these schemes are placed at Annexure-I.
