GROWTH OF MSME MANUFACTURING AND PLI
BENEFICIARIES IN TELANGANA

1685. DR. K. LAXMAN:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the status of MSME registrations on the Udyam Portal in the State of Telangana and the employment opportunities created thereby;
- (b) the initiatives taken to facilitate the participation of MSMEs from Telangana in the Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Schemes and the benefits accruing to them; and
- (c) the measures being taken to strengthen MSME clusters in key sectors such as pharmaceuticals and textiles in the State, including support for technology, infrastructure and market access?

ANSWER

(a): The number of MSMEs registered on the Udyam Registration Portal and Udyam Assist Platform as on 30.06.2026 in the State of Telangana are **44,22,548** and the employment reported is **2,49,27,621**.

(b): The Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade, Ministry of Commerce and Industry has launched the Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme in 2020 across the country, including the State of Telangana. The PLI Scheme, with an incentive outlay of ₹1.91 lakh crore, aimed at strengthening India's domestic manufacturing base. The scheme over time, has expanded to include 14 sectors ranging from electronics and textiles to automobiles and food processing.

(c): Under the Micro and Small Enterprises Cluster Development Programme, Scheme of the Ministry of MSME, a total of 28 projects comprising 02 Common Facility Centre projects and 26 Infrastructure Development projects have been approved in the state of Telangana to support for technology, infrastructure and market access.
