DIGITAL OVERHAULS, PORTAL LAUNCHES & DIRECT BANK LINKAGES

1688. SHRI VIJAY CHINTAKAYALA:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the newly launched PMEGP 2.0 portal has achieved full API data integration with the Jan Samarth portal to enable real-time bank loan disbursements and the number of PMEGP applications from Andhra Pradesh processed through this integration so far;
- (b) the number of rural micro-enterprises integrated into the Open Network for Digital Commerce ecosystem via the new MSME Global Mart 2.0 platform; and
- (c) the timeline for completing the end-to-end digitisation of testing center activities under the newly functional national MSME Testing Portal and whether the MSME Technology Centre in Andhra Pradesh has been brought onto this testing platform?

ANSWER

- (a): The newly launched PMEGP 2.0 portal has achieved full API-based integration with the JanSamarth Portal, enabling real-time, bi-directional flow of application-related data. 2 nos. of PMEGP applications from prospective entrepreneurs from Andhra Pradesh have been received on the PMEGP 2.0 portal.
- (b): No micro enterprises have been integrated into the Open Network for Digital Commerce (ONDC) ecosystem via the new MSME Global Mart 2.0 platform. However, MSME Global Mart currently has 80,372 registered micro enterprises, including rural micro enterprises, and serves as a platform to facilitate market access services for these enterprises.
- (c): The MSME Testing Portal is live and MSMEs and other users can book samples and download reports online. At present, all MSME-Testing Centres and Testing Stations functioning across the country have been boarded on the MSME-Testing Portal.
