SURVIVAL AND GROWTH OF MSMEs IN ODISHA

1690. DR. SASMIT PATRA:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the district-wise number of MSMEs registered, operational, closed and declared stressed in the State of Odisha during the last five years;
- (b) the details of credit sanctioned, subsidies provided and employment generated through the Central MSME schemes;
- (c) whether any assessment has been undertaken regarding the survival rate of MSMEs established with Government assistance; and
- (d) the measures taken to improve competitiveness and market access for MSMEs in the State of Odisha?

ANSWER

(a): Udyam Registration Portal was launched on 01.07.2020. The number of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) registered in Odisha on the Udyam Registration (UR) Portal and Udyam Assist Platform (UAP) is 24.68 lakh during FY 2021-22 to 2025-26 and 3453 MSMEs have been closed/shut down during the same period. District-wise MSMEs registered and closed in Odisha state is at **Annexure-I & II** respectively.

(b): Ministry of MSME implements Credit Guarantee Scheme (CGS) for Micro Small Enterprises (MSEs) through Credit Guarantee Fund Trust for Micro and Small Enterprises (CGTMSE) to provide credit guarantees for the credit facilities extended to MSEs. During the last five years (FY 2021-22 to FY 2025-26), a total of 2.92 lakh credit guarantees amounting to Rs. 34,156 crore have been extended to MSEs in Odisha State.

Ministry of MSME, through Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC), is implementing the Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP). It is a central sector scheme aimed at generating employment opportunities primarily in rural areas by assisting prospective entrepreneurs in setting up new micro enterprises in the non-farm sector.

During the last five year (FY 2021-22 to FY 2025-26) total number of micro enterprises assisted is 16,056, Margin Money Subsidy disbursed is Rs. 460.37 crore and estimated employment generated is 1,44,504 under PMEGP for Odisha State.

(c) & (d): The Procurement & Marketing Support (PMS) Scheme, implemented by the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME), provides financial assistance to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) to enhance their market access and competitiveness. Under the Scheme, eligible MSEs are provided financial assistance for participation in national and international trade fairs/exhibitions/expo's, Vendor Development Programmes (VDPs), National Workshops/ Seminars, adoption of barcodes, packaging improvements, and use of digital marketing platforms.

The government has undertaken a number of measures to promote procurement and market access for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) throughout country, including the State of Odisha, including:

- (i) The Ministry of MSME has notified the Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs), Order, 2012 vide Gazette Notification No. S.O. 581(E), dated 23rd March, 2012. The policy (amended in 2018) mandates 25% annual procurement from MSEs by Central Ministries/Departments/Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs), including 3% from MSEs owned by women entrepreneurs and 4% from MSEs owned by SC/ST entrepreneurs.
- (ii) The Ministry of MSME launched "MSME-SAMBANDH Portal" on 8th December, 2017. to monitor the procurement by Central Government Ministries, Departments and Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs).
- (iii) Government e Marketplace (GeM), an online portal, provides a platform to MSEs for procurement by Ministries/ Departments/ CPSEs.
- (iv) Vendor Development Programmes under the Procurement and Marketing Support scheme facilitate MSEs to integrate with supply chains of CPSEs. Special Vendor Development Programmes/ Buyer-Seller Meets are conducted by Departments/ CPSUs to facilitate SC/ST and women owned MSEs.
