**Development of AYUSH Infrastructure and implementation of NAM in North Eastern
Region**

169 Shri Terash Gowalla:

Will the Minister of *Ayush* be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of AYUSH hospitals, dispensaries, medical colleges and Health & Wellness Centres functioning in Assam and the other North Eastern States, State-wise;
- (b) the details of projects sanctioned under the National AYUSH Mission (NAM) in Assam during the last five years;
- (c) the funds sanctioned, released and utilized for these projects, year-wise; and
- (d) whether Government proposes to establish additional AYUSH hospitals, medical colleges or research institutes in Assam and the North Eastern Region, and if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER
THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYUSH
(SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV)**

(a) Public Health being a State Subject, primary responsibility regarding functioning of Ayush hospitals, dispensaries, medical colleges and Health & Wellness Centres in the North-Eastern States including Assam, lies with respective State Government. However, under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National Ayush Mission (NAM), as per the proposals received from North-Eastern States including Assam through State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs), the status of supported Ayush facilities for their smooth functioning is furnished as **Annexure-I**.

(b) & (c) The details of projects sanctioned in Assam, along with funds sanctioned, released and utilized under the NAM during the last five years are enclosed as **Annexure-II**.

(d) Public Health being a State Subject, the establishment of Ayush hospitals, medical colleges or research institutes in the North-Eastern Region including Assam, comes under the purview of respective State Government. However, under NAM there is a provision for establishment of 50/30/10 bedded Integrated Ayush Hospitals, new Ayush Medical Colleges,

Ayush Dispensaries etc. To avail the financial assistance suitable proposals are required to be submitted by States through SAAPs, as per NAM guideline.
