Will the Minister of Parliamentary Affairs be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government has launched an upgraded version of the National Youth Parliament Scheme (NYPS) portal, if so, the reasons for the said upgradation and the specific new features introduced therein compared to the previous version;
- (b) whether NYPS 2.0 allows participation from unregistered institutions, informal groups and individual citizens in addition to recognized educational institutions and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the cumulative number of institution-wise, group-wise and individual registrations recorded since the launch of the portal, State/Union Territory-wise details thereof; and
- (d) whether any target has been fixed for onboarding institutions, groups and individuals during the year 2026-27?

(a) to (c) The Ministry has launched an upgraded version of the National Youth Parliament Scheme (NYPS) web portal, known as NYPS 2.0, on 11th September 2024. Unlike the previous version, which was limited to students of recognized institutions only, NYPS 2.0 is open to all the educational institutions, groups, and citizens across the country. Since its launch, the details of institutional, group, and individual registrations recorded on the portal are as follows—
