Funds allocated for SAAPs

- (b) the number of Ayush Hospitals and Ayush Dispensaries that have been supported since 2014-15; and
- (c) the number of Ayush Grams that have been supported by the Ministry since 2014-15?

(a) to (c) Ministry of Ayush is implementing Centrally Sponsored Scheme i.e. National Ayush Mission (NAM) through State/UT Governments for overall development & promotion of Ayush Systems in the country. The financial assistance is being provided to the States/UTs for implementation of the various activities against the State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) submitted by them, as per NAM guideline. Accordingly, total amount of Rs. 6406.99 Crores were released by the Ministry under NAM as Central Share against the SAAPs received from States/UTs since 2014-15 to 2025-26. Under NAM, as per the proposals received, 228 Integrated Ayush Hospitals & 390 Ayush Dispensaries have been supported for establishment and 866 Ayush Hospitals as well as 10225 Ayush dispensaries have been supported for upgradation of infrastructure. Total number of 2440 units have been supported for Ayush Gram initiative.
