Will the Minister of Corporate Affairs be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the total expenditure incurred on Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) by Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) and private sector companies during the last five years;
- (b) the details of the major sectors in which CSR expenditure has been incurred by PSUs operating in the State of Rajasthan during the last five years;
- (c) the total CSR fund spent in Jharkhand in the last three years, constituency-wise, along with the details of approved and pending developmental projects and their completion timelines;
- (d) whether the Government has made any changes in the CSR policy to make CSR expenditure more effective and streamlined; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

(a): All data related to CSR filed by companies in MCA21 registry is available in public domain and can be accessed at www.csr.gov.in. On the basis of annual filings made by the companies in the MCA21 registry, the total CSR expenditure incurred by the companies in India during the FY 2020-21 to 2024-25 is at Annexure-I

(b): Development sector-wise CSR expenditure incurred by PSUs in Rajasthan during the FY 2020-21 to 2024-25 is at Annexure II.

(c): The Ministry does not maintain CSR data parliamentary constituency-wise and the completion status of CSR projects centrally. However, district-wise CSR expenditure in Jharkhand during the last three financial years from 2022-23 to FY 2024-25, is at Annexure-III.

(d) & (e): The CSR framework is disclosure based and CSR mandated companies are required to file details of CSR activities annually in the MCA21 registry. Under the Companies Act, CSR is a Board driven process and the Board of the company is empowered to plan, decide, execute and monitor CSR activities of the company based on the recommendation of its CSR Committee. The Ministry has vide Gazette notification dated 27.05.2026 widened the ambit of Schedule VII by introduction of new item no. (xiii) i.e. "Subscription to zero coupon zero principal instruments on Social Stock Exchange." This amendment will help Not for Profit Organisations to raise funding for public welfare projects in a transparent and regulated manner.
