MANUFACTURING OF FERTILIZER IN ODISHA

182: Shri Manas Ranjan Mangaraj:

Will the **Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government proposes to establish or revive fertilizer manufacturing units in Odisha;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the present status of such proposals; and
- (d) the likely employment opportunities to be generated?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) With regard to Urea, Talcher Fertilizer Limited (TFL), a new Greenfield Urea plant with production capacity of 12.7 Lakh Metric Tonne urea Per Annum is being set up at Talcher, Odisha through Joint Venture (JV) route after revival of Talcher Unit of Fertilizer Corporation of India Limited (FCIL). The overall progress of the TFL project as on 30.06.2026 is 72.56%. This is generating employment for unskilled/semi-skilled/skilled and experienced professionals, during the execution phase.

The Government has implemented Nutrient Based Subsidy (NBS) Scheme w.e.f. 01.04.2010 for Phosphatic and Potassic (P&K) Fertilizers under the Scheme, P&K fertilizers are covered under Open General License (OGL) and companies are free to import/manufacture these fertilizers or establish/revive fertilizer manufacturing units as per their business dynamics.
