ASSISTANCE PROVIDED TO THE STATES IN DISASTER

1996 SHRI ANURAG SHARMA:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government has provided assistance to the States affected by the excessive rainfall floods and landslides during the year of 2023-24, 2024-25 to till date;

(b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise, including Himachal Pradesh, Uttrakhand and Jammu and Kashmir;

(c) the total assistance provided to the States/UT under the SDRF/NDRF during the last three years;

(d) the steps taken by Government for deployment of NDRF teams during the current monsoon session for rescue and relief operation details of States specially in the State of Himachal Pradesh; and

(e) the measures being taken to enhance the preparedness, inter agency coordination and effective response both at National and State Level?

(a) to (c): As per the National Policy on Disaster Management (NPDM), the primary responsibility for disaster management, including disbursement of relief assistance on ground level, rests with the State Governments concerned. The State Governments undertake relief measures in the wake of natural calamities, from the State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) already placed at

their disposal, in accordance with Government of India approved items and norms. The Central Government supplements the efforts of the State Governments and provides requisite logistics and financial support. Additional financial assistance is provided from National Disaster Response Fund (NDRF), as per laid down procedure, in case of disaster of ‘severe nature’, which includes an assessment based on the visit of an Inter-Ministerial Central Team (IMCT).

Further, in the event of notified disasters, financial assistance to the States is provided from SDRF and NDRF, while in the case of Union Territories, the relief is provided from the Union Territory Disaster Response Fund (UTDRF).

The details of State-wise allocation and releases of funds under SDRF and NDRF during the years 2023-24 to 2026-27 (as on 23.07.2026) are as per Annexure-I.

Further, the amount allocated and released to the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir under Disaster Response Fund (DRF) under the Demand 58 during the years 2023-24 to 2026-27 (as on 31.07.2026) as given below:-

Also, for the floods/landslides of 2025, the Central Government has approved an amount of Rs. 330.34 crore from UTDRF for Jammu and Kashmir.

(d): The National Disaster Response Force (NDR Force) maintains close coordination with IMD, CWC & other Early Warning Agencies for timely inputs and prompt response. The NDRF Units remain in close and regular coordination with the concerned States/ District Authorities to undertake evacuation on requisition by States/ Districts. Further, the details of NDR Force deployments for rescue operations, rescues and evacuations during the current monsoon season 2026 (as on 22.07.2026) are as per Annexure-II.

(e): The Central Government has taken several measures to enhance disaster preparedness, inter-agency coordination and effective response at the National and State levels as given below:

- i. To strengthen early warning dissemination, the Common Alerting Protocol (CAP)-based Integrated Alert System (SACHET) has been operationalised and the Cell Broadcast System (CBS) has also been launched for immediate dissemination of geo-targeted alerts.**
- ii. The India Meteorological Department (IMD) has integrated Artificial Intelligence (AI)/Machine Learning (ML) models into weather forecasting systems for providing seven-day advance weather forecasts. The Central Water Commission (CWC) has initiated an AI/ML-based pilot project for developing short-range flood forecasting models for flood forecasting stations on rivers across the country.**
- iii. The National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) has developed a web-based Dynamic Composite Risk Atlas and Decision Support**

System (Web-DCRA & DSS Tool) for disaster risk assessment and response planning, while the National Remote Sensing Centre (NRSC) has developed Flood Hazard Atlases for flood-prone as well as other vulnerable States/UTs to support preparedness and planning.

These initiatives, together with continuous strengthening of forecasting, monitoring and decision support systems, facilitate better preparedness, improve inter-agency coordination among disaster management stakeholders at the National and State levels, strengthen early warning dissemination, and enable timely and effective response to disasters.
