EX-AGNIVEERS AND CAPF VACANCIES

2000 SHRI PRAVEEN CHAKRAVARTHY:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) the number of Agniveers who will complete their four-year engagement during 2026 and the number the Ministry expects to seek absorption in the Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) and Assam Rifles (ARs);

(b) the number of vacancies currently unfilled in the CAPFs and Assam Rifles, force-wise, and the number expected to be notified during 2026-27; and

(c) the number of ex-Agniveers recruited into the CAPFs to date under the reservations announced for them?

(a) & (b) Under the Agnipath scheme, 75 % of the total Agniveers of 1st batch is expected to complete their 4 years engagement in the Armed Forces. The government has made provision for reservation of 50% vacancies for the post of Constable (General Duty)/Rifleman in CAPFs & AR.

(c) As of now, the first batch of Agniveers have not yet completed their term of engagement.
