Consumption of fertilizers

200 Shri Golla Baburao:

Will the **Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS** be pleased to state:

- (a) the demand, supply and consumption of fertilizers in the last three years and current year, year-wise and season-wise;
- (b) whether it is a fact that there is 41 per cent increase in demand for fertilizers in 2025-26 due to good monsoon;
- (c) if so, the details of domestic production and the details of imports to meet the demand and the fertilizer subsidy that Government has to forego in 2025-26 when compared to ₹1.9 lakh crores spent in 2024-25;
- (d) how agreements with Saudi Arabia, Jordan, Morocco, Qatar and Russia are helping the country to strengthen supply security; and
- (e) the impact of El-Nino on fertilizer consumption in this season?

ANSWER

(a) to (e) The information regarding the requirement assessed by DA&FW, availability and consumption of fertilizers, viz. Urea, DAP, MOP and NPKS, during the last three years and the current year (up to 14.07.2026), year-wise and season-wise, is placed at **Annexure**.

Further, the total requirement for fertilizers was 649.43 LMT during 2024-25, which increased to 677.18 LMT during 2025-26. Thus, the overall requirement for fertilizers increased only by 4% (approximately) during 2025-26 as compared to 2024-25.

The total consumption of fertilizers, namely Urea, DAP, MOP and NPKS, is 151.74 LMT during the ongoing Kharif 2026 season (01.04.2026 to 14.07.2026), as against 157.05 LMT during the corresponding period of Kharif 2025 (01.04.2025 to 14.07.2025).

Indian fertilizer companies have signed agreements for import of 31 LMT of DAP from Saudi Arabia, 2.50 LMT of MOP from Jordan, 25 LMT of DAP/TSP from

Morocco and 30.10 LMT of DAP/ NPKs from Russia during 2025-26. These agreements have facilitated significant quantities of fertilizers from these countries, thereby strengthening fertilizer supply security.
