FUNDING, DELAYS AND COST ESCALATION UNDER BHARATMALA PARIYOJANA

2032. SMT. RANJEET RANJAN:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:-

- (a) the year-wise details of funds mobilised for Bharatmala Pariyojana through budgetary support, borrowings, private participation and asset monetisation during last five years;
- (b) the number and value of Bharatmala projects whose completion timelines have been revised beyond the originally scheduled date, indicating the average duration of delay; and
- (c) the year-wise and State-wise/UT-wise details of delays and cost escalation under Bharatmala Pariyojana attributable to land acquisition, environmental clearances, utility shifting and other implementation constraints?

- (a) A total of ₹1,45,559 crores has been mobilized from monetization of National Highways (NHs) assets by National Highways Authority of India(NHAI) during last 5 financial years, as per the details:-

(b) & (c) Bharatmala Pariyojana Phase-I was approved by the Government of India in 2017 covering a length of 34,800 km across the country at an estimated outlay of Rs. 5,35,000 Crore. Under the program, projects covering a total length of 26,425 km had been awarded. Out of this, 22,709 km has already been constructed upto May 2026. State-wise details of the projects under Bharatmala Pariyojana are annexed.

New sanctions of projects under Phase-I of Bharatmala Pariyojana have been discontinued since November 2023.

The primary reasons for delay in National Highway (NH) projects are issues / bottlenecks relating to land acquisition, delay in getting statutory clearances, utility shifting, encroachment removal, law & order, non-availability of construction material / minerals, poor performance of Contractor / Concessionaire, and Force Majeure events like Covid-19 pandemic, heavy rainfall, etc. The project under Bharatmala is targeted for completion by 2028-29.

To expedite project execution, various initiatives have been undertaken including streamlining the land acquisition process through Bhoomi Rashi portal, revamping the Parivesh Portal through Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change to expedite forest and environmental clearances, enabling online approval of General Arrangement Drawings (GAD) for Road over Bridges (ROBs) and Road under Bridges (RUBs) from the Railways, and conducting review meetings at various levels with all stakeholders, including State Governments. Government is taking all efforts to ensure timely completion of the projects.
