COVERAGE OF BENEFICIARIES UNDER ICDS

2064. SHRI MALLIKARJUN KHARGE:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) number of children aged 6 months to 3 years, 3 to 6 years, adolescent girls, pregnant, and lactating women, among others enrolled under ICDS, State-wise, year-wise for past five years;
- (b) details of beneficiaries receiving supplementary nutrition daily under each category, including weaning food, morning snacks, hot cooked meals, take-home ration, State-wise, year-wise for last five years;
- (c) details of immunisation and supplementation provided including coverage for vaccine-preventable diseases such as poliomyelitis, diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus, tuberculosis and measles, State-wise, year-wise for last five years; and
- (d) details of beneficiaries and their outcomes under each ICDS component, State-wise, year-wise for last five years?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) In the 15th Finance Commission, components of nutritional support for children below the age of 6 years, pregnant women and lactating mothers, Adolescent Girls (14 – 18 years); Early Childhood Care and Education [3-6 years]; Anganwadi infrastructure including modern, upgraded Saksham Anganwadi, Poshan Abhiyaan and Scheme for Adolescent Girls were reorganised under Mission Saksham Anganwadi and Poshan 2.0.

Under Mission Saksham Anganwadi and Poshan 2.0, a new strategy has been developed for reduction in malnutrition and for improved health, wellness and immunity through activities like community engagement, outreach, behavioural change and advocacy. It focuses on Maternal Nutrition, Infant and Young Child Feeding Norms, treatment of Severe Acute Malnutrition (SAM)/ Moderate Acute Malnutrition (MAM) and wellness through AYUSH practices to reduce prevalence of wasting, stunting, anaemia and being underweight.

Under Mission Saksham Anganwadi and Poshan 2.0, a package of six services i.e Supplementary Nutrition (SNP), Pre-school Non-formal Education, Nutrition & Health Education, Immunization, Health Check-up, and Referral Services are provided to the eligible

beneficiaries through Anganwadi Centres across the country. Three of the six services, viz., Immunization, Health check-up and Referral Services are related to health and are provided through National Health Mission (NHM) & Public Health Infrastructure. These services are provided to the eligible registered beneficiaries i.e children up to the age of 6 years, Pregnant Women and Lactating Mothers across the country and Adolescent Girls in the age group of 14 to 18 years in Aspirational Districts of all States and all districts of North Eastern Region through the platform of Anganwadi Centre.

The Ministry has introduced 'Poshan Tracker' digital application as an important governance tool for real time monitoring and tracking of all Anganwadi Centres (AWCs), Anganwadi Workers (AWWs) and beneficiaries on defined indicators under Mission Saksham Anganwadi and Poshan 2.0. Poshan Tracker app has enabled the Ministry to review the implementation of the scheme on various parameters and to make course correction. It has facilitated near real time data collection for Anganwadi Services such as, opening of AWCs, daily attendance of children, ECCE activities, Growth Monitoring of children, Provision of Hot Cooked Meal (HCM) and Take-Home Ration (THR), Growth Measurement etc.

State and UT wise, year wise details of different categories of beneficiaries registered on Poshan Tracker, beneficiaries receiving supplementary nutrition and details of growth monitoring parameters are available on the Poshan Tracker at the link: <https://www.poshantracker.in/statistics>.

As per the information received from Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, the State/UT wise details of the antigen wise coverage for vaccine-preventable diseases, including BCG vaccine, Oral Polio Vaccine (OPV3) 3rd dose, Pentavalent 3 (In India, Pentavalent vaccine is given for Diphtheria, Pertussis & Tetanus) and Measles Rubella (MR) vaccine 1st dose, for the last 5 years across the country is placed at Annexure.
