EMPLOYMENT THROUGH NCS PORTAL IN ODISHA

2185. SHRI SUBHASISH KHUNTIA:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of job seekers from Odisha registered on the National Career Service (NCS) portal during the last five years;**
- (b) the number of employers and vacancies registered on the portal from the State during the said period;**
- (c) the number of registered job seekers from the State who secured employment through the portal, year-wise; and**
- (d) the measures taken to improve registration, employer participation and placements in the State?**

ANSWER

(a) to (d): The National Career Service (NCS) Portal is a one-stop solution for providing career related services including jobs from private and government sectors, information on online & offline job fairs, job search & matching, career counselling, vocational guidance, information on skill development courses, skill/training programmes etc. through a digital platform [www.ncs.gov.in] to all stakeholders across the country.

As on 15.07.2026, more than 9.66 lakh jobseekers and more than 1.83 lakh employers are registered on NCS portal in the State of Odisha during the last five years i.e. 2021-22 to 2025-26. Also, more than 8.16 lakh vacancies have been mobilized in the State of Odisha during the same period. Further, notifying final hiring figures is not a mandatory requirement on NCS Portal.

The Ministry has signed several Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) with public and private employers/portals/platforms to strengthen public-private partnerships to expand employment opportunities for jobseekers. Till date, more than 40 MoUs have been signed with partners such as APNA, Swiggy, Rapido, Zomato, Amazon, TCS iON, Quikr and FoundIt (Monster), among others. These partnerships facilitate the integration of employment opportunities and services with the NCS Portal, including vacancy aggregation, organisation of job fairs, skill development programmes, career counselling and other employment-related support services.

NCS portal is also integrated with various Government portals such as Udyam, eShram, Skill India Digital Hub, EPFO, ESIC, MHRD DigiLocker, etc. and has linkages with Government recruitment bodies like Union Public Service Commission, Staff Selection Commission, Agricultural Scientists Recruitment Board, Railway Recruitment Boards etc.

Further, as on date, 31 States/UTs (including Odisha) have been integrated with the NCS portal including 8 States/UTs which are directly using NCS Portal.
