VIKSIT BHARAT YOUTH PARLIAMENT

SHRI MANAN KUMAR MISHRA:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) the manner in which Government plans to expand the newly introduced 'Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament' scheme format to non-collegiate rural institutions during the current Financial Year;
- (b) the number of female students winning top honors during the national-level evaluation round;
- (c) whether the integrated online evaluation portal has successfully automated institutional registrations screening process to prevent region-wise participation backlogs;
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) the details of the allocation made and released to State coordinators for organizing localized mock parliament sessions in aspirational districts; and
- (f) the enhancements introduced to translate official resource training-materials into all 22 scheduled regional-languages this quarter, if any?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS

(DR. MANSUKH MANDAVIYA)

- (a) The Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament (VBYP) is a programme of the Department of Youth Affairs, which aims to provide young voices with a formal platform to deliberate on pressing national issues, interact with policymakers, and contribute meaningfully to India's developmental journey. Since its inception, the programme has been open to all youth in the age group of 18-25 years. The eligible youth from rural as well as urban areas, including youth from non-collegiate rural institutions participate in VBYP by registering on the MY Bharat Portal and following the prescribed selection process.
- (b) Two female participants in VBYP-2026 won the top honours during the final round of national-level event held at Samvidhan Sadan, New Delhi.

(c) & (d) This year the VBYP has been conducted entirely in offline mode through a three-tier competitive structure comprising the District, State, and National Rounds. The registration of participants is done through the MY Bharat portal and is open to all youth between the age group of 18-25 years, which ensures a transparent and technology-enabled registration process.

(e) The details of allocation made and released to aspirational districts for organising Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament during F.Y 2025-26 is placed at Annexure-1.

(f) Does not arise. The programme, in its current format, does not envisage any official training material.
