INCENTIVE FOR KAKATIYA MEGA TEXTILE PARK IN WARANGAL

2395. SHRI ANIL KUMAR YADAV MANDADI:

Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there has been persistent demand from various stake holders including the peoples representative to provide enhanced Central incentives and policy support for the Kakatiya Mega Textile Park (KMTP) in Warangal, Telangana, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether Government has taken final decision regarding extending enhanced Central incentives and policy support for the Kakatiya Mega Textile Park (KMTP) in Warangal, Telangna on the basis of demand of various stake holders including people's representative; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR TEXTILES

(a) to (c): Post the announcement of the PM MITRA Scheme in October 2021, all states were requested to submit their proposal for selection under the scheme. The Ministry received 18 proposals from 13 states for setting up Mega Textile Parks under the scheme. 7 sites were selected out of which 5 are under the Greenfield category and 2 fall under the brownfield category. Government of Telangana proposed Kakatiya Mega Textile Park (KMTP), Warangal for selection under the scheme, which was selected under brownfield category. Under the PM MITRA Scheme Guidelines, Brownfield PM MITRA Parks are eligible for Development Capital Support (DCS) of up to ₹200 crore for development of infrastructure. In addition, the Scheme provides for Competitive Incentive Support (CIS) to incentivize establishment of manufacturing units in the Park, up to ₹300 crore per Park, wherein the incentive can be provided to manufacturing units up to 3% of the total sales turnover on first come first serve basis.
