MSMEs REGISTERED ON UDYAM PORTAL

2489. SHRI NARAIN DASS GUPTA:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of MSMEs registered on the Udyam Portal, State-wise;
- (b) whether Government has assessed the credit requirements of MSMEs and measures taken to improve access to finance;
- (c) the details of employment generated by MSMEs during the last five years; and
- (d) the steps taken to enhance technology adoption and competitiveness among MSMEs?

ANSWER

(a): The Ministry of MSME launched Udyam Registration Portal (URP) on 01.07.2020 and Udyam Assist Platform (UAP) on 11.01.2023. The State-wise number of MSMEs registered on URP and UAP as on 31.07.2026 is at **Annexure-I**.

(b): As informed by Reserve Bank Of India (RBI), total credit outstanding to Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) as on 31.03.2026 is Rs. 38.35 lakh crore. Further, the Government of India has taken a number of initiatives to provide financial assistance to MSMEs, which inter-alia includes:

- i. Scheduled Commercial Banks have been mandated not to accept collateral security for loans up to ₹20 lakh extended to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs).
- ii. Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), provides Margin Money subsidy up to 35%, for setting up of new micro enterprises, in the non-farm sector with project cost of ₹50 lakh for manufacturing and ₹20 lakh for Service enterprises.
- iii. Under Credit Guarantee Scheme (CGS) for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) guarantee coverage for collateral-free institutional credit upto Rs. 10 crore are given to eligible MSEs.
- iv. Under Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY), collateral-free institutional credit up to ₹20 lakh has been provisioned.
- v. Ministry of MSME implements Self-Reliant India (SRI) Fund for providing growth equity support to MSMEs through daughter funds.

(c): As per URP and UAP, the total employment reported by MSMEs till 31.07.2026 is **40,61,77,747**.

(d): The Ministry of MSME implements the MSME Champions Scheme, which comprises the MSME Sustainable (ZED) Certification Scheme, the MSME Competitive (Lean) Scheme, the MSME Innovative (Incubation, Design, and IPR) Scheme, and the Procurement and Marketing Support (PMS) Scheme to facilitate technology adoption, quality improvement, innovation, and market access. Further, to enhance competitiveness and exports from the MSME sector, the Government has approved the Export Promotion Mission (EPM) to strengthen the overall export ecosystem. Under the EPM, support is extended through Niryat Protsahan which focuses on trade finance facilitation for MSME exporters and Niryat Disha providing non-financial assistance, including export quality and compliance support, market access interventions, logistics facilitation, and export ecosystem-building measures.
