STATUS OF JAGDISHPUR–HALDIA–BOKARO–DHAMRA PIPELINE

- (a) the present status of the Jagdishpur–Haldia–Bokaro–Dhamra Natural Gas Pipeline (Pradhan Mantri Urja Ganga Project) in the State of Odisha;

- (c) the reasons for delay, if any; and
- (d) the expected date of completion and commissioning of the project?

(a) to (d): GAIL India Limited (GAIL) is executing the Jagdishpur–Haldia–Bokaro–Dhamra Natural Gas Pipeline (JHBDPL) Project, popularly known as the Pradhan Mantri Urja Ganga Project. The entire pipeline sections of the JHBDPL Project in the State of Odisha are operational. The pipeline connectivity to Cuttack has been provided through the Spur Line of the Dhamra–Angul Pipeline, which was commissioned on 31.03.2023.
