PRODUCTION AVAILABILITY AND DISTRIBUTION OF UREA

2572. SHRI MANMOHAN SAMAL:

Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

- (a) the year-wise details of domestic production, imports, availability and consumption of urea in the country during the last five years;
- (b) the State/UT-wise allocation, supply and consumption of urea during the said period, along with the district-wise details for Odisha;
- (c) the year-wise details of subsidy released, production and distribution of neem coated urea and nano urea;
- (d) the plant-wise installed capacity and production of domestic urea manufacturing units; and
- (e) the measures taken to ensure timely availability of urea and reduce import dependence?

ANSWER

(a):The year-wise details of domestic production, imports, availability and consumption of urea in the country, during the last five years is given as under:

(d): The plant-wise installed capacity and production of domestic urea manufacturing units is given at Annexure-II.

(e) : The following steps are taken by the Government every season for ensuring timely and adequate supply of fertilizers in the country, including in the State of Odisha:

- i. Before the commencement of each cropping season, the Department of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare (DA&FW), in consultation with all the State Governments, assesses the State-wise & month-wise requirement of fertilizers. On the basis of requirement projected by DA&FW, Department of Fertilizers (DoF) allocates adequate quantities of fertilizers to States by issuing monthly supply plan and continuously monitors the availability.
- ii. The movement of all major subsidized fertilizer is monitored throughout the country by an on-line web-based monitoring system called integrated Fertilizer Management System (iFMS).
- iii. The gap between demand (requirement) and production for urea & other fertilizers is met through imports. The import for the season is also finalized well in advance to ensure timely availability.
- iv. The State Governments are regularly advised to coordinate with manufacturers and importers for streamlining the supplies through timely placement of indents.
- v. Regularly coordinate with the Ministry of Railways for giving sufficient rakes, priority to fertilizers and for timely evacuation of rakes for States.
- vi. The distribution of fertilizers within the State at district level is done by the concerned State government.

Accordingly, the availability of urea has remained adequate in the country as well as in the State of Odisha during the last five years (i.e. in FYs 2021–22 to 2025–26).

Under the New Investment Policy (NIP) – 2012, in order to make India self-sufficient in the urea sector, 6 new urea units have been set up which includes 4 urea units set up through Joint Venture Companies (JVC) of nominated PSUs and 2 urea units set up by the private companies. The units set up through JVC are Ramagundam urea unit of Ramagundam Fertilizers and Chemicals Ltd (RFCL) in Telangana and 3 urea units namely Gorakhpur, Sindri and Barauni of Hindustan Urvarak & Rasayan Limited (HURL) in Uttar Pradesh, Jharkhand and Bihar, respectively. The units set up by private companies are Panagarh urea unit of Matix Fertilizers and Chemicals Ltd. (Matix) in West Bengal; and Gadepan-III urea unit of Chambal Fertilizers and Chemicals Ltd. (CFCL) in Rajasthan. Each of these units has installed capacity of 12.7 Lakh Metric Tonne per annum (LMTPA). These units are highly energy efficient as they are based on latest technology. These units have together added urea production capacity of 76.2 LMTPA, thereby total indigenous urea production capacity (Reassessed Capacity, RAC) has increased from 207.54 LMTPA during 2014-15 to 269.42 LMTPA currently.

Also, the Government had notified the New Urea Policy (NUP) – 2015 that led to additional production of urea by 20-25 LMT as compared to the production during 2014-15 annually.

In addition to this, on 15.07.2026, the CCEA has approved New Investment Policy for Urea (NIPU) for Aatmanirbhar Bharat-2026 for making fresh investments in Urea Sector.
