SUPER-SPECIALITY BLOCKS IN GOVERNMENT MEDICAL COLLEGES

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government had set up Super Speciality Blocks (SSB) in the existing Government Medical Colleges/Institution in the State of Telangana;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether Government has any proposal to set up Super Special Blocks (SSB) in the existing Government Medical Colleges/Institutions in the State of Telangana;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a) & (b) Under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY), three Government Medical Colleges (GMCs)/Institutions in the State of Telangana have been upgraded by way of construction of Super-Specialty Blocks and procurement of medical equipment, on a Centre–State cost-sharing basis. These Government Medical Colleges/ Institutions are namely:
- (i) Nizam Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad;
 - (ii) Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Adilabad; and
 - (iii) Kakatiya Medical College, Warangal

(c) to (e) Under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY), there is no proposal to set up Super Specialty Blocks (SSB) in other existing Government Medical Colleges/Institutions in the State of Telangana.
