PROGRESS MADE UNDER THE PMSGMBY

Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) the progress made under the PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana (PMSGMBY), including the number of rooftop solar installations completed and the total capacity installed since the launch of the Scheme;
- (b) the State-wise details thereof, including the number of beneficiary households and installed capacity in Haryana; and
- (c) the estimated reduction in electricity bills, carbon emissions and peak power demand achieved under the Scheme?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) The PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana (PMSG: MBY) is a demand-driven scheme wherein all residential consumers in the country, having a grid-connected electricity connection with the local DISCOM, can avail the benefits of the scheme, for installation of rooftop solar (RTS) systems by applying on the National Portal (www.pmsuryaghar.gov.in) of the scheme.

Under the scheme, since its launch in February 2024, a total of 77,65,047 applications have been received, 41,94,051 rooftop solar (RTS) systems with a cumulative installed capacity of 14,894.95 MW have been installed, benefitting 50,43,893 households and an amount of Rs. 28,390.50 crore has been released as Central Financial Assistance (CFA) across the country, as on 05.08.2026. The state/UT-wise details are placed at **Annexure**.

Similarly, Under the scheme, since its launch in February 2024, a total of 1,95,485 applications have been received, 1,19,525 rooftop solar (RTS) systems with a cumulative installed capacity of 393.10 MW have been installed, benefitting 1,29,492 households and an amount of Rs. 771.79 crore has been released as CFA in the State of Haryana, as on 05.08.2026

The electricity bills of consumers with installed RTS under the scheme have been largely reduced, over 18.93 lakh beneficiaries have been reported by DISCOMs across the country, to receive zero electricity bill after installation of RTS systems under the scheme during any month/billing period, depending on their self-consumption of electricity.

Under the PMSG: MBY, it has been estimated that RTS installation in one crore households may produce renewable electricity of 1,000 billion units, which may result in reduction of 720 million ton of CO₂ eq emission during the 25 years of lifetime of the RTS systems.
