**COOPERATIVE INSTITUTIONS, SOCIETIES, MARKETING AND  
PROCUREMENT**

2728 SHRI NARAIN DASS GUPTA:

Will the Minister of COOPERATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has assessed the performance of newly established national cooperative institutions and societies;
- (b) the details of cooperative societies registered during the last three years, State-wise;
- (c) whether Government proposes to introduce digital platforms for strengthening cooperative marketing and procurement; and
- (d) the steps taken to improve access to finance for cooperative societies?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF COOPERATION  
(SHRI AMIT SHAH)

(a) Yes sir, the Ministry of Cooperation periodically reviews the performance of newly formed three national-level multi-state cooperative societies i.e., National Cooperative Exports Limited (NCEL), National Cooperative Organics Limited (NCOL), and Bharatiya Beej Sahakari Samiti Limited (BBSSL).

(b) The State-wise details of multi-state cooperative societies registered during the last three years is placed at **Annexure-I**.

(c) Yes sir, the Government has introduced several digital platforms to strengthen cooperative marketing and procurement. The registration and onboarding processes of BBSSL have been digitised through the 'Bharat Beej' portal. The portal enables cooperative societies to register and onboard with BBSSL seamlessly and facilitates their access to quality seeds, processing support and market linkages, thereby strengthening cooperative marketing and procurement.

In so far as NCOL is concerned, it leverages digital platforms to facilitate cooperative marketing and procurement through the marketing of "Bharat Organics" products on various e-commerce platforms. It has also adopted QR code-based product traceability and digital inventory systems for supply chain management. In addition, NCOL facilitates the digital onboarding of cooperative societies and certified farmer groups to enable their participation in procurement and market linkages through digital platforms.

Under the Atmanirbharta Abhiyan, NCCF and NAFED have developed the e-Samyukti and e-Samridhi portals for registration of farmers and procurement of tur, masur, urad and maize at Minimum Support Price from pre-registered farmers.

(d) National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC), a statutory body under the Ministry of Cooperation, Government of India, is mandated to promote economic development through cooperatives by strengthening farmer institutions, enhancing productivity, and supporting pre & post-harvest infrastructure.

NCDC has been providing financial assistance to the cooperative sector under its Corporation-sponsored schemes as well as various schemes of the Government of India, covering a wide range of notified commodities and services, as amended from time to time. In recent years, NCDC has introduced sector-specific schemes and focused products to align with the evolving needs of the cooperative sector, with special emphasis on new cooperatives, women empowerment, rural healthcare etc. thereby strengthening the cooperative infrastructure.

Since its inception, NCDC has cumulatively disbursed ₹5,74,090.48 crore for the development of cooperative institutions across the country. Out of which ₹3,96,763 crore has been disbursed for cooperative development during the last five years.
