PM SHRI Schools in Assam

2749 **Shri Jogen Mohan:**

Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of PM SHRI Schools approved and operational in Assam, district-wise;
- (b) the funds released for strengthening infrastructure and smart classrooms under the scheme;
- (c) whether Government proposes to include additional schools from Assam under the PM SHRI scheme; and
- (d) the expected outcomes of the scheme in improving the quality of school education?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): Under PM SHRI scheme, as of now, a total of 447 PM SHRI schools including 65 Central Government schools (38 Kendriya Vidyalayas and 27 Navodaya Vidyalayas) have been selected from the State of Assam. The district-wise number of PM SHRI schools selected under PM SHRI scheme in the State of Assam is attached as **Annexure**. The details of PM SHRI schools may be accessed on the website of PM SHRI scheme at the link: <https://pmshri.education.gov.in/state>.

An amount of ₹200.44 crore central share has been approved for Assam since the inception of the scheme for the strengthening of infrastructure of PM SHRI Schools out of which ₹160.50 crore has been released in the State of Assam. The approved works include construction and development of Additional Classrooms, Art/Craft Rooms, Biology Laboratories, Boys' Toilets, Boys' Toilets (Pre-Primary), Chemistry Laboratories, CWSN Toilets, Drinking Water facilities, Girls' Toilets (Pre-Primary), Language Laboratories, Library Rooms, Major Repairs, Minor Repairs, Physics Laboratories, Ramps and Handrails, Repair of Dysfunctional Boys' Toilets, Repair of Dysfunctional Girls' Toilets, Science Laboratories, and installation of Solar Panels in PM SHRI schools across the State.

Out of the above approval, a central share of ₹5.46 crore, has been approved for the establishment of smart classrooms.

(d): Under PM SHRI scheme, PM SHRI schools aim to showcase all the initiatives of National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, be the exemplar schools, and offer benchmarking leadership to other schools in the neighbourhood. These schools provide leadership in their respective regions in providing high- quality education in an equitable, inclusive and joyful school environment that takes care of the diverse background, multilingual needs, and different academic abilities of children and makes them active participants in their own learning process as per the vision of NEP 2020.
